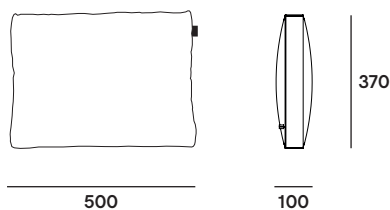

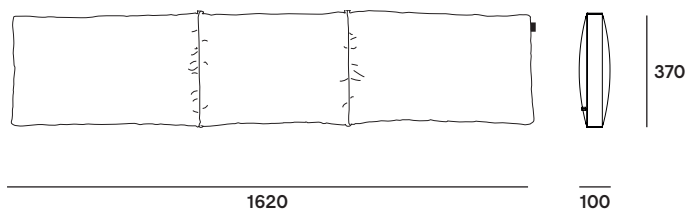

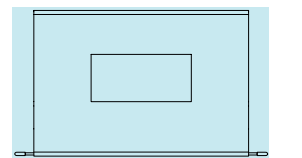

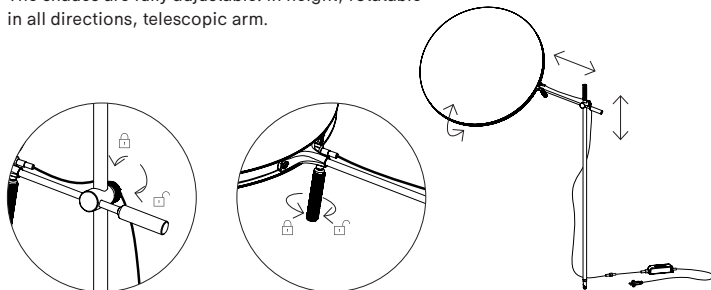


- Sol+Luna had an optional cover.

## How to use the shade

The shades are fully adjustable: in height, rotatable in all directions, telescopic arm.



## Maintenance

### POWDER COATED PARTS

- White powder coating obviously requires more maintenance.

### SUNBRELLA

- Shake or brush off loose dirt immediately.
- Spray Extremis Multi Cleaner.
- Use a soft brush and make circular movements.
- Let the suds soak in for a moment.
- Rinse thoroughly to remove all soap residue.
- Simply allow to dry.
- It's also possible to put the blanket and the pillow covers in a washing machine (max 40°C). Follow the cleaning instruction on the label.
- If the cushion has metal brackets, we recommend turning the cover inside out first to avoid damaging the washing machine. In this case, leave the zipper open about 10 cm.

### PARASOL FABRIC

- Shake or brush off loose dirt immediately.
- Spray Extremis Multi Cleaner.
- Use a soft brush and make circular movements.
- Let the suds soak in for a moment.
- Rinse thoroughly to remove all soap residue.
- Simply allow to dry.

### STAINLESS STEEL

- Clean regularly with a dry cloth and some stainless steel cleaner

## F.A.Q.

Q: Can I alter the side of the backrest after assembly?

A: No, but you can choose the side at which the backrest has to be placed while assembling. The place can be changed afterwards, but you'll need tools for that.

Q: Can the cushions stay outside?

A: Yes, but we recommend to store the cushions inside when not used.

Q: Can the parasol stay outdoors?

A: Yes, but we recommend to use a parasol cover.

Q: Do you need to use a parasol cover?

A: Using a cover is strongly recommended for use in most climates around the world. Protect your parasol from polluted rain, bird droppings, dust and heavy winds to avoid marks or stains on the parasol fabric.

## Warnings

### General

- Do not use any sharp tools to open the packaging.
- We strongly advise against using power tools.
- Tripping hazard, mind your step.
- Do not put out cigarettes on the (sofa) sunbed.
- Not graffiti proof.
- Do not leave children unattended whilst playing on the (sofa) sunbed.
- To avoid danger of suffocation, keep plastic bags away from babies and children.
- Colors can differ over years and from batch to batch.

### Product

- Stackable up to 5 pieces.
- Always stack Sol+Luna with 2 people.
- The cushions can stay outside, but we recommend to store the cushions inside when not used.
- It is not necessary to cover the caps on the legs, but we recommend to use them in case the holes are not used for accessories.
- Do not put your fingers in the holes for accessories.
- Do not sit on the tapa table, linking table or backrest.
- Only use Extremis accessories on Sol+Luna.
- Children must not be allowed to adjust the position of the head rest.
- Adjust the position of the head rest with care, to avoid getting your fingers trapped in the hinge system.
- Sitting on the head rest is only possible when it is at

its lowest setting (i.e. perfectly horizontal).

- Do not put anything except Extremis accessories in the holes provided for that purpose: no fingers, chewing gum, cigarette butts etc.
- Do not stand or jump on the Sol+Luna.
- Max. 4 people or 320 kg on the sunbed.

### Powder coating

- White powder coating requires more maintenance.
- Do not use abrasive scouring powders or scourers as they will scratch the surface.
- Color can fade to some extent when exposed to UV.
- Flame retarding - NEN-EN13501-1 A2-sl - Satisfying the same criteria as Class B for the SBI-test according to EN13823. In addition, under conditions of a fully developed fire these products will not significantly contribute to the fire load and fire growth.
- Dark colors can get very hot in sunny weather.

### Batyline

- Shake or brush off loose dirt immediately.
- Never use abrasive substances or solvents.
- Simply allow to dry.
- Very good UV color fastness: Elab < 3 UVA 340 / 2000h.
- Flame retarding: M2 x B1.
- Jeans can leave dye marks on white Batyline, just as they can on other seating fabrics.

### Sunbrella

- Not waterproof, store inside!
- Shake or brush off loose dirt immediately.
- UV color fastness: 7/8 (ISO 105-B02).

### HPL

- UV color fastness: >6 (EN438-2:27) en (ASTM G53-91)

### High-tech polyester

- Shake or brush off loose dirt immediately.
- Do not use any aggressive detergents as they will remove the protective coating of the fabric.
- We strongly advise you not to use a high-pressure hose for cleaning.

### Stainless steel

- Very good UV color fastness.
- Flame retarding: NEN-EN13501-1 A1 - Class A1 products will not contribute to fire in any stage, including fully developed fire. For this reason, they are assumed to be capable of satisfying all requirements of all lower classes as well.
- Watch out, stainless steel isn't entirely rustproof! Be sure to avoid contact with iron objects. If it does show signs of rust, clean with rust remover as quickly as possible.
